



How to Draw:
Rowlet
from
Pokemon Sun & Moon




Step 1:
Draw a circle for the body and head. It should be a little taller than wide (so it is actually an ellipse).




Step 2:

On the upper half of the circle (actually a bit bigger), draw two large overlapping circles. About one third of the circles should overlap.



Step 3:

In the center where the circles overlap, draw a large ellipse for the beak. Draw a rounded line two thirds the way down to separate the two halves of the beak and a short vertical line in the middle of the top half of the beak. On either side where the circles do not overlap draw a large ellipses for each eye. They should be about half the height of the circles, and about a third of the total circle width. Inside each of those ellipses, draw a circle for the highlight of the eyes. We will color the main part black in a later step.



Step 4:

It is time to draw the leaf bow tie. Beneath the beak (about the height of the black part of the eye) draw a side ways figure eight or infinity symbol. However make sure to point the ends so they look like leaves. You can also add a line horizontally down the center of the leaf to indicate the leaf is not flat and folds slightly in the center.




Step 5:

Add in some feathers to form the wings, they should be long and finger like but overlap a fair amount. Add a line on each side between the body and feathers. This will separate the belly from the body.



Step 6:
Add a few curved line segments on the bottom of the body to indicate where the legs are.



Step 7:
Draw some lines for the feet. A general shovel shape will work for the right foot facing forward. The left foot is more like the top half of a long extruded ellipse.



Step 8:
Finish the feet by drawing in a few lines to indicate the toes. We will be erasing the extra line between the toes in the next step.



Step 9:
Now that we have mapped out where everything goes, it is time to erase any construction lines and darken your finished lines. For a more cartoon look you can draw over it in ink, then erase all of the pencil lines once the ink dries



Step 10:

It is now time to color the drawing. The bow tie should be green, the feet a nice orange and the wings and most of the body a light brown.

If you color with something you can't color over top of, leave spaces for the later highlights and shading.



Step 11:

Add shading and highlights to make Rowlet seem round. Congratulations, you finished!
